- Scholarship awards range \$2,500 \$20,000
- Students and schools <u>do not</u> need to be SME members to apply for scholarships
- Students <u>must create</u> an SME account to complete and submit a scholarship application
- STEM Courses include any courses in science, technology, engineering, computer/IT, mathematics, or others specific to a manufacturing/engineering pathway.
- The Application requires contact information for two references. The references are then contacted to complete their portion of the scholarship application.
